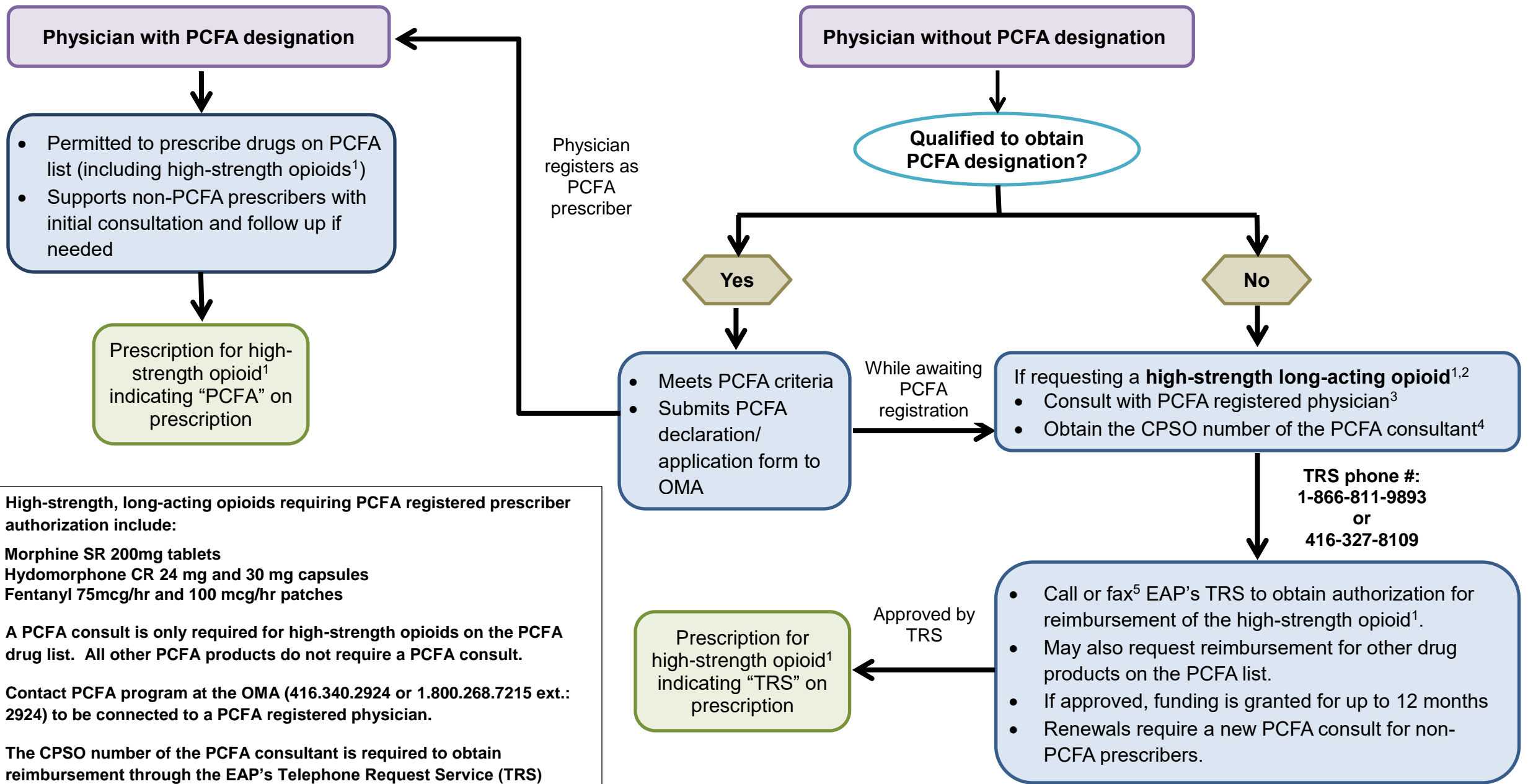


## Palliative Care Facilitated Access Process (PCFA)



1. High-strength, long-acting opioids requiring PCFA registered prescriber authorization include:
  - Morphine SR 200mg tablets
  - Hydromorphone CR 24 mg and 30 mg capsules
  - Fentanyl 75mcg/hr and 100 mcg/hr patches
2. A PCFA consult is only required for high-strength opioids on the PCFA drug list. All other PCFA products do not require a PCFA consult.
3. Contact PCFA program at the OMA (416.340.2924 or 1.800.268.7215 ext.: 2924) to be connected to a PCFA registered physician.
4. The CPSO number of the PCFA consultant is required to obtain reimbursement through the EAP's Telephone Request Service (TRS)
5. Requests faxed to EAP are required to meet the same criteria as on TRS. The CPSO number of the PCFA-registered consultant must be provided on the EAP application.
